

## Mini Lesson 2: What's the Weather Like?

**Grade Level:** Kindergarten

**Curriculum:** Weather

K-ESS2-1 Use and share observations of local weather conditions to describe patterns over time

**Tools:** PowerPoint & Kahoot

**Synopsis:** For this lesson, I will be using PowerPoint and Kahoot. Throughout the school year, I will have my students observe the weather every day at 2pm. Each day we will add the weather to a PowerPoint. The PowerPoint will contain a slide for each month and within that slide will be a chart for each day and the weather (sunny, cloudy, rainy, windy, or snowy). At the end of the year I will review the slideshow as a whole class and I will ask students what patterns they recognize. I will also ask them which month's weather they liked the most. Once we are done reviewing the PowerPoint, the students will play Kahoot as a class. This Kahoot will contain easy questions such as a picture of a sun and asking what type of weather that is, but it will also contain harder questions like which month was the rainiest and how many days did it snow.
