Classroom rules:

- 1. Always respect your peers, teachers, and yourself.
- 2. Always listen quietly when someone is talking.
- 3. Always raise your hand before talking.
- 4. Always come to class prepared: sit down quietly with pencil sharpened ready to learn
- 5. Bullying, harassing, and cheating will not be tolerated-*this will be an automatic office referral*

Rules for technology and internet usage in the classroom (includes, but not limited to, computers, iPads, and laptops)

- 1. Respect the equipment- These objects are expensive and privilege for the school to have. If you notice something broke or not working, notify the teacher right away.
- 2. No food or drinks allowed around the media center or when you have the iPad out on your desks.
- 3. You are only allowed in the media center or have an iPad out when the teacher allows it. The announcement for these could vary throughout the day.
- 4. While in the media center, a timer will be set so that everyone has a chance to use it.
- 5. No more than two students at a time unless otherwise allowed by the teacher.
- 6. Cyberbullying, harassment, or inappropriate website usage will not be tolerated *this will result in an automatic office referral*
- 7. Use only the apps that are downloaded do not download anything without the teachers permission.
- 8. Only access the internet with the teacher's permission. If you access something that does not look appropriate, notify the teacher.

- 9. Do not give out or enter any personal information on the internet.
- 10. Only use your log in and password. Never use someone else's information.

Consequences for breaking my rules:

First offense will result in a warning. Second offense will result in five minutes of missed recess and a written note sent home to your parents. Third offense will result in an office referral with another letter sent home to your parents.
