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“How To” using Clips to record it.

This is a “how to” on making a turkey out of paper plates and other items.

Things you will need:

paper plates, paint, construction paper, googly eyes, yarn or string, and glue.

First- Put your name on the backside of the plate so you know can keep with yours easily.

Second-You will want to paint plate to represent the feathers. Let that be drying while you work on cutting out the head of the head, beak, and snoods (the red thing that hangs down by the beak) of the turkey.

Third- glue down the head towards the bottom of the plate. Glue the beak and snood down in the middle of the head. Glue the eyes just above the beak.

Fourth- Add a string or yarn to the back so it can be hung from the ceiling or wherever you choose.

Let your project dry completely.

I am using Clips to show a “how to” for my students on how they can make a turkey decoration. This project is used to have a little break from normal class work and let the kids show their creative side. I will have the video playing while they work so they can refer back to it as they move along.
