CLASS RULES

- 1. Follow directions quickly
- 2. Listen while others are talking
- 3. Keep hands, feet and all other objects to yourself.
- 4. Be kind with words and actions
- 5. Be the best you can be.

Your child will also be allowed to access technology in the classroom and below a few rules/guidelines in which our class will follow:

TECHNOLOGY RULES

- Handle technology with care (use two hands, make sure hands are clean, no food or drink)
- Practice internet Care (only use app or website instructed by teacher, keep log in and passwords secure)
- Care for others around you (keep noise down to a minimum, use head phones as needed)
- 4. Inform teacher on any unusual activity (unauthorized chat, other students bullying, etc.)
- 5. If using work from the internet, make sure to cite.

Students will NOT be able to:

- 1. Visit web sites that are inappropriate (not related to the lesson)
- 2. Cyberbully (this includes sending messages, talking about other students online, etc.)
- 3. Plagiarize
 (all students must cite where they have found the information and not use as one's own)
- 4. Vandalize or misuse any type of technology

(iPads, Chromebooks, smartboards, etc)

5. Enter any type of chatroom

Consequences for not abiding in classroom rules and or Technology rules

- 1. 1st Offense: Verbal Warning
- 2. 2nd Offense: Parent Contact/Loss of Computer time for a day (additional assignments not using technology will be given)
- 3. 3rd Offense: Parent Contact/Office Visit/ Loss of Computer for a week (additional assignments not using technology will be given)

*Additional assignments are at the discretion of the teacher. Depending of the severity of the offense, a student may reach 3rd offense automatically. Cyberbullying, inappropriate website, and chat rooms will not be tolerated.
