I have also listed the consequences for not following the rules. Please read the information carefully with your child as these rules are designed to ensure your child has a safe and positive environment. After reading the information, I will need the form signed by you and the child and returned back to school.

Classroom Rules:

1. I will **FOLLOW** directions the first time.
2. I will **LISTEN** when Ms. Ashley or a friend is speaking.
3. I will **RESPECT** others.
4. I will **ALWAYS** raise my hand before answering a question.
5. I will **SIT** in the seat assigned to me.

Technology Rules:

1. I will only enter the computer center when Ms. Ashley gives me permission.
2. I will only access the apps Ms. Ashley has placed on the home screen.
3. I will stay in the computer center while using the computer/iPad.
4. I will not throw or hit the computer/iPad.
5. I will plug up my device so that it may be charged for the next friend to use.

Rules are subject to change throughout the year according to needs of the classroom. Parents and students will always be notified if a change is to occur.

Internet Rules:

1. I will only access the website Ms. Ashley gives to me.
2. I will never give out any personal information.
3. I will never click on something I am confused about.
4. I will not talk to any strangers online.
5. I will **NOT** cyberbully.



Consequences for Breaking Classroom and Technology Rules:

1st Offense: Warning

2nd Offense: No recess

3rd Offense: Note or phone call to parent/guardian

4th Offense: Meeting with parent/guardian and a meeting with the principal

Consequences for Breaking Internet Rules:

1st Offense: Warning

2nd Offense: Loss of technology privileges for a week

3rd Offense: Meeting with parent/guardian and a meeting with the principal
