Classroom Rules:

Classroom Rules for Using Technology:

4. iPads will be checked out for a maximum of thirty minutes. *I may change this based on the assignment.*
5. Students will stay on task while using the iPad.



Classroom Rules for Internet Use:

1. I must approve Internet sites before getting on the Internet.
2. If something on the Internet makes you uncomfortable, come tell me immediately.
3. No cyberbullying will be tolerated! Be respectful of others online.
4. Do not give any information about yourself to anyone on the Internet.
5. Do not download anything unless I have approved it first.

Additional Information:
