**Cost:** Free to download, membership for \$29.99 quarterly or \$59.99 yearly (says it requires a membership but we went around that and played the games)

**Description:** Even though the name says 1<sup>st</sup> grade math, it actually has math games for grades for K-5<sup>th</sup>. The grade is broken down by math topic that then takes you to a math game. The games will ask you a question which you receive coins for getting correct. It allows the student to keep trying until they can answer correctly. They can then use those coins to pick out “pets” to put in their aquarium or jungle. If the student needs to work out a problem, then they can pull up the scratch work option to work out the problem.

**Impression:** This app would be very beneficial to use in the classroom. The students can feel like it personalized to them by getting to select the animals. When you create an account, it asks you if you are in the classroom or at home, so this is something that parents could get at home with a student that might be struggling. We like that it addresses all learning styles by allowing the student to work it out, listen to the question, and see the math problem. We also like that the questions get harder the longer the student works, so they are challenged to really test their knowledge.
