**Cost:** It is a free download, but you can only get two of the games free before purchasing a membership that is \$4.99 monthly, \$19.99 half-yearly, or \$29.99 yearly.

**Description:** Coding Games for Kids is an app that allows younger children to get a beginning taste of what coding is. It allows the student to play simple little games, like connecting the fire truck to the fire by placing the right segment of the road down. As the student accomplishes the first level, they go to a harder level with 3 sublevels in one level before going to the next level up.

**Impression:** This app is so kid friendly and was easy to access. It was very appealing with the different colors and sounds it made. Everything was easy to navigate and the app was easy to learn. Students could use this app to get started with coding. It is only acceptable for grades K-2 to really use, but it would be great to put in a “fun” center because the students will only think they are playing a bunch of games.
