**Description:** Splice is a movie making app. It gives you a tutorial to follow for your first time using the app. It walks you step by step when creating a movie every time though. You select the pictures you want to use and then it leads you to add in transitions, movies, and titles. You can add audio and make a voice over to explain what is happening in the video. You can also just record yourself and make that into a movie like the other ones. It is very straight-forward and does not use a lot of fancy terminology or tools to create a movie.

**Impressions:** We loved this app because it was so easy to use that our students would have been able to use it as well. The only thing that we did not like is that you had to shrink your pictures or turn them horizontal so that your top of the picture did not get cut out. It was very easy to use with step by step instructions. It was not very eye-catching though but that helped you focus on creating the movie at hand. It is a lot like iMovie just more straightforward and can be used on things other than Apple products. In the classroom, the teacher could use this to explain a project or lesson with the voiceover option. The students could also use this to explain their process in a project or explain the pictures that they have selected.
