Classroom Rules

Technology Rules

Internet Rules

1. No cyberbullying will be tolerated.
2. Only visit approved sites.
3. Do not save or download anything without permission.
4. Be respectful.
5. Do **NOT** give out any personal information to anyone or anything on the internet.

Consequences for breaking any rules will go as followed:

First Offense: Verbal Warning

Second Offense: Letter sent home to parent

Third and Final Offense: Send student to the office and/or a parent teacher conference.



Plagiarism, Copyright, and Fair Use Policies

- Copyright is a legal right that gives the creator of an original work to decide whether or not their work can be used by others on the internet.
