

- Title: Explain Everything
- Version 5.2.4 (updated 2 days ago)
- Publisher: Explain Everything sp. z o.o.
- Target Audience: 4+ years, after messing with the app, our group was able to figure out the gist of it, but it is definitely too complex for young students. We feel like it is more suited for middle school/high school students.
- Type(s) of software with your justification: The only software type we felt that this app fit into is tools because the teacher can use the app to create videos, shows, and documents to present and share in class. It also gives the option to collaborate on projects and communicate through voice chat. Therefore this app is a tool/resource that could be used to walk a student(s) through different stages of an assignment or subject.
- Curriculum(s) - This app could be used in the curriculum to provide one-on-one help with students who are outside of the classroom, whether they are struggling with a certain problem, or the missed a class and are falling behind. This could also be used to walk the class through a project in a step-by-step live instructional presentation.
- Possible environment(s) and Why: This app would fit into the lab setting and mobile environment. The lab setting environment because students would each be using their own iPad or computer to participate in the presentation. The mobile environment because students would need access to their own iPad to follow along, the presentation would strictly be app centered.
- Cost
 - There is a free 14 day trial, but after that a monthly plan is available for \$12.99 and the Explain Everything Whiteboard app is available for \$14.99. There are also yearly subscriptions available for \$107.99.
 - All costs listed above are for individual plans, there are group pricing options available, but the app requires more information from the user before sending pricing plans.
 - The in-app purchases include upgrading to the Explain Everything individual annual or monthly plans.
- Write a paragraph or two describing the software
 - Explain Everything is an online whiteboard that provides an interactive, collaborative way to view and edit a presentation. There are available editable templates, blank projects, and the option to edit files that are saved elsewhere. The app is similar to prezzi, because it is an interactive presentation app, but also similar to google because it is possible to edit and create a template with whomever the link is shared.

 - Our group was not fond of this app because it was not very user friendly and required multiple attempts before figuring out basic functions. However, we could see where an app like this could be handy in presenting content in a fun, interactive way. This could provide a more hands-on approach for those kinds of learners, but it would require supervision and explanations more than anything.
