

Title: BrainPop

- Version: 3.1.9 (Featured Movie)
- Publisher: BrainPOP
- Target Audience: 4+ but geared for 9-11
- Type(s) of software with your justification: Drill & Practice, Discovery Learning
- Curriculum(s) - This would be a great app to use in the classroom to review subject matter or help students gain more knowledge on a subject. The quizzes and videos can be used to enhance a lesson, or to assign for out of class work (homework).
- Possible environment(s) and Why: This software can be used as a teacher tool, to enhance a lesson, or as a single user, so the student can work at their own pace.
- Cost
 - Our group downloaded the free version, but there are multiple forms of the app (BrainPop Jr., BrainPop ELL, and BrainPop in Spanish/French). All forms start out free, but there is the option to upgrade in the app.
 - For classroom use (3 computers=\$230/annual), for school use (unlimited access through school site @ home or in class=\$1795).
 - In app purchases include upgrading the app to include more content access
- Write a paragraph or two describing the software
 - The app provides information on different topics that fall under the subjects; Science, Social Studies, English, Math, Arts/Music, Health, and Technology. Each subject breaks down into topics, each topic consists of units, and each unit provides detailed information through related videos for students to watch and a quiz to test what they learned. When in the unit, students can watch related movies, then take the corresponding quiz. This is a great resource for teachers to use in class to test student knowledge and introduce them to a new topic.

 - Our group loved this app, Kelsey had previous experience with it so she already knew quite a bit about it. This could be a great tool to use in class to enhance lessons through short video clips and corresponding quizzes. For student use, it is easy enough that it would not require supervision if students were using it on their own. In all honesty, it would be worth the money to have access to more videos and quizzes, the app contains over 800 quizzes and videos.
