

Mini Lesson Four

Grade level: 3rd

Topic: Social Studies

Standard: C.2.3.2 Demonstrate the procedures for recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance and proper etiquette for the Arkansas and American Flags

Materials needed:

Arkansas Flag

American Flag

Copies of the Pledge of Allegiance of America for each student

Large copy of the Pledge of Allegiance of America posted in the front of the room

Instruction: The teacher will begin by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance to the students 3–4 times. The students will join in on the last time following their copy or the large room copy of the Pledge of Allegiance. Students will memorize this and one by one recite the Pledge of Allegiance in the hall to the teacher. The teacher will then go over the meaning of each flag (The USA flag and Arkansas flag.) The appropriate handling will be discussed and what our flag stands for. Students will end the lesson by coloring pictures of the USA and Arkansas flag.
