The Specdrums tool looks like something that would be a lot of fun for the kids. For younger students it is an interactive way to teach colors. You could have the class go on a scavenger hunt for colors and record the sounds of the colors they find. In upper elementary music teachers could use this to introduce different concepts of music. As they progress through junior high and high school the tasks can become more complex and build on their musical knowledge. It's hard to imagine how I would integrate this type of tool in a mid-level ELA or History class, but it certainly has a place in the educational world for students and teachers. A music teacher could utilize it in so many ways.
