Cost: We used the free version which allows you to practice addition skills. You can pay a one-time fee of \$3.99 to remove ads and unlock the other 3 math skills for practice.

About the Software:

Kids Learn Math Training Games allows the user to practice addition skills (in the free version) along with multiplication, subtraction, and division (in the \$3.99 version). This app is very colorful and operates by presenting the user with a math problem and giving them 4 options to choose from. If the correct answer is chosen, a large green checkmark appears and clapping plays. If the wrong answer is chosen, the selected answer shakes and plays a ding sound. The user has unlimited attempts when answering problems.

<u>Impressions and Classroom Usage:</u>

This app is perfect for students of any age to use. The backgrounds are kid-friendly and the colors are fun and pleasing to the eye. The app is also very simply designed, which makes navigation a breeze. We do wish that you didn't have to pay to unlock the other 3 math skills, but at least it isn't a monthly subscription. We can see ourselves using this to help our students who are struggling with learning a particular math skill get some extra practice. This app would also be a great recommendation for students to have at home so that they can continue to practice their math skills when they aren't at school. The app could also become a class activity by being shown up on the board and having students take turns or call out answers.
