Software Type(s): Qrafter is a tool that allows users to scan and create QR codes.

About the Software:

Qrafter allows users to create QR codes and to also scan QR codes. This app is completely free to use and does feature ads, which can be removed for \$3.99. Users can make QR codes from scratch and customize them by making them different colors. Users can also save their codes, share them to social media, and print them using AirPrint (if available on the device).

Impressions and Classroom Usage:

Overall, this app is a very simple QR reader and creator with the unique idea of having the ability to change the QR code color. We really liked how the app has a help section that explains how to use it, tips for scanning and creating codes, and also how your specific device's camera works when reading codes. The app is straightforward with labeled buttons and functions pretty quick. We would use this app to create codes to send our students on a scavenger hunt, put in learning centers, and to also have our students create their own codes about different topics.
