Facts About Arkansas Interactive PowerPoint

I would use this interactive PowerPoint in a unit about Arkansas history. We would first learn about Arkansas and the topics addressed in the PowerPoint (state flower, year of statehood achievement, state vegetable, et cetera). After we have gone through our unit and learned about our state, I would use this PowerPoint as a way to test my students' memory and knowledge about what they learned. Ideally, I would create teams and make it a fun team game at the end of our unit. This would serve as a refresher before we take an assessment.

Native Plants of Arkansas E-Book Use

I would use this e-book to supplement a science and history lesson collaboration. We would learn about the different types of plants (flowers, shrubs, trees, et cetera) and what they need to survive. We would talk about how some plants need more sun than others, some need more water, et cetera. We would also discuss the meanings of words like "evergreen" and "perennial" in our lesson. I would then bring native plants of Arkansas into the lesson and discuss some of the most popular plants. We would read the e-book as a class and learn about the plants.
