

**Title:** Explain Everything

**Version:** 5.2.3

**Publisher:** Explain Everything sp.

**Target Audience:** Explain Every is age rated at 4+. Other than the interactive whiteboard use, I would not suggest this app for student use. Explain Everything would be highly beneficial for teacher use.

**Curriculum:** Due to the vastness of this app, it could be utilized for practically any subject.

**Possible Environment:** I would suggest use of Explain Everything in the regular classroom by teaching professionals. Explain Everything is a great lesson planning and instructional tool. It could be incorporated for student use, but I believe there are simpler apps that students could use to reach the same goal.

**Cost:** There is a 30-day free trial of Explain offered in the AppStore. Once the 30-day trial is complete, users can choose to purchase the \$12.99 monthly subscription or the \$9.00 a month subscription that is billed annually.

Explain Everything is a presentation app. It is similar to PowerPoint with a Smart Board type feature. The app allows users to integrate material from outside sources. You can import photos, videos, PDF files, movies, etc. Explain everything would be an excellent tool for creating lesson plans or tutorials for students. The app also has an interactive whiteboard feature. This is the only portion of the app that I would suggest for student use.

As a future educator, I do not see myself using Explain Everything. Although the app is wonderful for collaboration, I do not believe the cost is worth it. It would not be an app that students would get very much use from and I believe there are similar apps that teachers can utilize for lesson planning. The only benefit students would have is the interactive whiteboard. What I do like about the app is the freedom to create. There are no boundaries, but it just seems a bit too complex for student use.
