**Cost:** Initial download cost \$3.99. There is no free version offered, but once the app is purchased, there are no further cost.

The app offers traditional aspects of a tea party such as tea, cakes, cookies, tablecloths, dinnerware and much more. The app is colorful and engaging for students as well. Students can individually design their tea party and then “invite” their classmates. The students will interact on their own devices but will work collaboratively at the same tea party. The app promotes kind greetings and interactions amongst guest. Students will encounter the decision making process while building their desired tea party, and explore social skills when interacting with others. Toca Tea Party is excellent for expanding imaginations, building social skills and decision making skills.

As a future educator, I believe this app would be beneficial and fun for students. Social skills and decision making skills is not something that can be taught from a book, it must be explored in a real-life scenario. I love that this app offers a real-life scenario without all of the cleanup and mess a real tea party would bring for teachers. I highly enjoy the fact that students can work collaboratively. The only downside to this app is that there is a cost. I have explored similar apps that are free, but they just do not seem as beneficial.
