Basic Classroom Rules

- 1. No talking while the teacher is talking
- 2. Keep your hands, feet, and other objects to yourself
- 3. Stay in your seat during class unless told otherwise
- 4. Raise your hand to speak during the lesson
- 5. Listen when others are talking, do not interrupt



Technology Rules

- 1. Can get on iPads and/or computers for 20 minutes at a time
- 2. Stay on the app/program that you are told to be on at all times
- 3. When your time is up, take turns with your classmates at your table
- 4. Do not change the volume of the iPad or computer
- 5. Don't throw at or hit your classmates with the iPad or other technology ***Note: Can be changed depending upon special circumstances

Internet Rules

- 1. No cyberbullying of any form (threaten, harass, target)
- 2. Do not click on other games or advertisements
- 3. No downloading or searching any other games/apps other than those provided
- 4. Do not search the Internet for anything I did not assign
- 5. Do not put any personal information on the Internet



Consequences

- Basic Classroom Rules: Warning is given to student. If behavior persists, student receives a card change and sits in a "time out" area for ten minutes. In the next offense, the student receives a card change and does not get to participate in recess (or no iPad time) and the parent/quardian will be notified.
- Technology/Internet Rules: Depending upon the severity, a student could receive a card change (Ex: not taking turns), sent to time out (Ex: throwing or hitting) with parent notification, or sent to the principal's office directly (Ex: plagiarism, cyberbullying).

Additional Information

- Plagiarism: copying off someone else, using someone else's work/idea as your own, or turning in an assignment from any other class.
- Copyright: students must ask permission before using a copyrighted work or use images/articles that are licensed under Creative Commons.
- Fair Use: some copyrighted material may be quoted verbatim without permission
