Other ways to use iMovie

I could use iMovie to record the progress of something. For example, if the class has a plant that we are tracking the growth of for the month I could record the plant a few seconds each day and at the end of the month we could create a movie and watch how the plant grew.

I could use iMovie to record how to videos to show students how to make something. For crafts or other projects, I could record myself doing it to show the students in class. This way while I am showing the video, I could also be walking around helping students.

I could use iMovie to provide out of school experiences. For snow days I could record myself teaching and send it to students to watch. I could even make iMovie's that help students work and understand certain concepts that they could watch and refer to if they were trying to do homework and got stuck.
