20 minutes	Instruction: Students will view the padlet I have created on their device and add to the content.	Students will have an opportunity with support from me to explore the content provided to them, as well as an opportunity to strengthen the content by providing their own information and adding to the Padlet. I will walk amongst my students allowing for assistance and an opportunity to ask questions. I will engage them in the activity with open ended questions to scaffold their learning about the topic.
5 Minutes	Closure: I will project the padlet for the class to go over the new information	As a whole class, we will explore the additions to the padlet, allowing students an opportunity to share their findings about the topic. I will also ask for feedback, with a thumbs up or down, for the information that was provided by asking if it was credible or relevant to the topic. The contributors names will be visible, this will help students stay on task and be good digital citizens.
