The type of software used is Discovery Learning because the student can choose which Island to explore and what they want to learn.

This app can fit into the curriculum for when we are learning phonics, sight words, and tracing words. It would be a great way for students to learn more or even just practice.

It is free to get, but there are In-App Purchases monthly \$5.49 and yearly \$39.99. You can try it for free for 7 days.

When you open the app you click on a play button to get started to visit the Islands, there is a Phonics Island, a Sight Word Candyland Island, a Letter Puzzles Island, a Phonics Farm Island, a Tracing Island, and a Sight Words in Space Island. To navigate to each island you swipe left or right and click on the play button on the island you want to choose. Whichever island you choose you can either choose to learn using flash cards or you can play games and choose learning adventures. Each island has different games for their adventures, and you can also choose which age group you are and it will adapt. You can choose which game you want to play, for example if you want to play bingo it will show you a bingo card and say the words you need to choose.

The software was child friendly and easy to navigate. The islands were creative and colorful, which kids would enjoy. There are a lot of background noises but you can turn them off by going to settings. When you get something correct the voice says "Great Job" and when you

get something wrong it says "Nuh-uh" quickly. There are a lot of games for kids to choose from and many different subjects for them to learn. It all has to do with language and writing, and it is a game that I would have my class use when learning phonics and spelling.
