educator.

The software upon opening it allows you to sign in as a member or a guest. It is very plain and boring. No music, sound, or color. Just a list formation and endless options upon scrolling for a topic the app is for pre-k through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

This software is not made for young children at all. It has an audio option – but you have to click on the sound speaker to access it. There is not a positive reward system. At the top of the screen you are timed, and it keep tracks of progress, the ribbons you earn. If you get one wrong... you back track so hard that it is impossible to catch up your score goes from 110 to 88 in one wrong, click. This looks like it might work for assessment of student knowledge. The students need supervision. The tutorial has to clicked on to activate.

This was not easy to navigate the assignment and overall, there nothing appealing about this at all.
