45	<p>I will give the students a week ahead of this lesson to get the needed materials, which is a video recorder. If a student does not have one I will be able to provide only one. I will put them into groups of 5 beforehand so that only one of the students will need to bring a recorder.</p> <p>The day the lesson is set to go the students will get out their recorders (cameras, phones, etc..) and get into groups.</p> <p>I will ask the students to reenact the story we have recently read called “Goldilocks and the Three Bears”. I will have the script up on the board, and I will also give the students a piece of paper with the script on it as well.</p> <p>The students will get 12 minutes to film their reenactments. One student will film, one will be Goldilocks, and the other three are the bears. Once each group has finished they will move on to editing the video.</p>

They will use WeVideo to edit their reenactment and the PC's that are in the classroom. I will give them the remaining time to do so. I will also help them get started and help them navigate the tool.

They will share their videos with me so I can grade them.

I will then ask the students about the key details in the story, the setting, characters, and other main information about the story they have reenacted.
