

Cyber Bullying and Security with Technology Tail and BrainStorm/Padlet

1. Any grade, but more angled at 3rd-5th grade
2. Cyber Security/Bullying Awareness
3. The Technology Tail and BrainStorm (iPhone app) or Padlet
4. We will first read the Technology Tail and I will share about a time I was cyber-bullied to show them that even adults can be mean online behind the safety of a screen. I will open up the floor for any student to share about their bullying experience. Then, each student will either create a BrainStorm or Padlet that outlines five things: ways people bully, consequences of bullying on the person hurt, classroom rules we should have about bullying, classroom consequences if you are caught bullying, and how to improve our cyber security. If we use BrainStorm, students will share their ideas into a class-wide list and we will discuss adding these rules and consequences to our classroom chart. If we use Padlet, I will read through many of the padlets and have students explore different websites or ideas. Then we will come together and vote about adding rules and consequences to our classroom chart.
