Online Tools

Tool number one is Quizlet. Quizlet is a website where students or teachers are able to group information and use it to turn into study material. You put in words with their definitions and you can either make it into flash cards, drill and practice games, or just look at it in list view. The way I would use this in the classroom, would be to create study guides through this website for my students, so that they could go online and study for tests. Tool number two is ClassCraft. ClassCraft is a tool that teachers can use to create an interactive video game that incorporates what you are learning in the classroom.
