Basic Technology Rules

- 1. No food or drinks are allowed near the electronics
- 2. One student per device (Unless instructed otherwise)
- 3. <u>30 minute time limit during free time</u>
- 4. Carry electronics with both hands
- 5. <u>Only access approved websites, do not play games on the computers when you are supposed to be</u> <u>doing work on them</u>


Technology no-no's

- 2. Do not cyberbully (making fun of or being rude to other people online)
- 3. Do not give out personal information online (Where you live, your age, etc.)
- 4. <u>Never download apps without asking for permission first</u>
- 5. Don't speak to strangers, even on the internet

Additional Information

- 1. <u>Plagiarism</u> Copying someone else's work or ideas and using it as if it is your own, this can be all OR some of the work
- 2. <u>Copyright</u> Legal right given by originator in able to purchase to own by another person
- 3. <u>Fair Use</u> In U.S. law, the ability for some to use a brief excerpt of copyright material without permission based upon certain criteria
