

Parts of a Book and its Content

Grade Level: Kindergarten

Curriculum Topic: Reading

State Standards:

- RL.K.3 With prompting and support, identify characters, settings, and major events in a story.
- RI.K.5 Identify the front cover, back cover, and title page of a book.

Tools:

- A copy of “If you give a mouse an iPhone” by Ann Droyd
- Quizizz online quiz on parts of a book
- Projector
- Smartboard

Synopsis: In this lesson students will identify the front cover, back cover and title page of the book “If you give a Mouse an iPhone” by Ann Droyd. Students will also be able to identify characters, settings, and major events in the book. To start the lesson off students will sit at the rug up front around the teacher. The teacher will have a copy of “If you give a Mouse an iPhone” by Ann Droyd. Before reading the book the teacher will prompt the class to see if any of the students can identify the front cover, back cover, and title page of the book. Spend around 5 minutes going over this and make sure students have an understanding before moving forwards. Before reading the book tell the students to

listen closely and see if they can identify the characters, setting, and major plot points of the book. Start reading the book but stop frequently to ask students questions about the characters, setting and plot points. After you finish reading the book have a class discussion on who they believe the characters of the books are, what the settings were in the book, and ask students to identify plot points in the book. After the class discussion is complete have students return to their seats and load up the “Parts of a Book” quiz on Quizizz using the classroom projector and smartboard, take this quiz together as a class and give each student enough time and an opportunity to voice their opinions on the answer.
