

## *Specdums Color Match*

**Grade Level:** Kindergarten

**Curriculum Topic:** Art

**State Standards:** R.8.K.1 Identify art by subject matter

**Tools:**

- Class set of Specdrums
- Color PowerPoint
- Class set of iPads
- Projector
- YouTube, YouTube video (<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9mruaPDxoEw>)

**Synopsis:** This lesson will go over the colors of the rainbow as a mini lesson combined with an activity. This activity will need a class set of iPads and Specdrums. The teacher will have a PowerPoint pulled up and ready to go that will match this activity, for example you could have random slides that simply say the colors name. Have multiple slides in different orders and allow multiples of the colors. Make sure all students have a Specdrums at their desk along with an Ipad that is paired up to the Specdrums. When everyone is sent up and everyone is ready the teacher needs to go over the rules of the activity before beginning. The rules would be for students to press their Spectdrums rings to the color that is associated to the colors name, the colors will be randomized and it will only state the colors name it will not show the color itself. The students must connect the colors name to the corresponding

color on Spectdrums, this activity can only go over the colors of the rainbow since those are the main colors on the Spectdrums board. After explaining the activity to the class begin the PowerPoint slide and give students 15 seconds to chose the color that corresponds with the color name, keep going until all colors are covered at least twice! At the end of the activity turn on the “Colors of the Rainbow” song on YouTube and allow the class to sing/dance along! <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9mruaPDxoEw>
