YouTube is video-sharing platform that can range from educational videos to entertainment videos all on one site. Many families and students will already be familiar with YouTube so it would be an easy online tool to use in the classroom that wouldn't take much time to learn or adjust to. I could use YouTube to upload mini lessons and attach them to my website or link other users educational videos onto my website for students and parents to view and learn from. Quizizz is an online quiz maker that can be used to create quizzes, homework assignments or class activities. Quizizz also has a lesson section that is currently in the beta stage. Quizizz allows users to assign homework and even has a function to do live quizzes! Each quiz gives a certain amount of time that the creator can choose that the students will get to answer the question before it moves on to the next question. I would use Quizizz to create online homework assignments and quizzes over topics we are going over in class. Quizizz has one of the easiest layouts for quiz making I have ever used and I highly recommend this site! I could also create extra little quizzes that I can add to my website for extra learning materials that can be used at the child's home! Talking Points is a communication platform for teachers and families. Talking points allows teachers to message parents but with a twist that emails or text messages typically don't have, Talking Points translates the messages into different languages as needed!
