DESCRIPTION OF APP:

This is a software that acts like a whiteboard for a teacher to write or post notes as students follow along. Teachers can allow students to watch or collaborate by providing a class code to gain access. The user can record audio, animations, and annotations to their notes or templates. Templates are available to users to create graphic organizers, diagrams, and more to enhance lessons or projects. When creating a note board or template, various tools are available in the app to use.

#### **OUR REVIEW:**

Our first impression of the app was good due to the video tutorials within the app. It helps the user become familiar with what the app can do. We believe this app was user friendly due to easy to use navigation, great graphics, multimedia, collaboration options and a live option. Teachers could use this app as they lecture in class, give assignments for students to do at their convenience, and in getting students involved in class. As the teacher receives the assignments from students, teachers can grade and return student's work digitally.
