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Teacher Tools Grader

This is version 3.4.4 of the Teacher Tools Grader app. It was created by Alfredo Delgado. The publisher created the app with teachers in mind. We agree that this app would be appropriate for teacher use. This is a tool software. The app allows you to fill in how many questions there were on a test, and it will tell you if the student missed one question, they made this percent, two questions and they made this percent, and etc. This would make the grader process quicker and easier because you wouldn't have to calculate each student's score. The app also has a reading test scorer, where you say how long the student read for, how many words they read, and how many errors they made, and it will tell you their reading level. Lastly, the app has a stopwatch to assist with said reading tests. Teachers could use this app for any part of the curriculum in which there is an assessment. The app is completely free, and there are no in app purchases.

The app is very simple, but it is meant to be. There is no complicated process, you simply fill in the appropriate information and it tells you what you need to know. The app doesn't store answers, so you would still need to write each score down in your gradebook as you grade. We can see this being used by any teacher who is up late at night trying to get tests or assignments graded. It just makes grading easier. It does precisely what it is meant to do, nothing more. Because it simplifies the grading process and is free, the app passes review and evaluation as a good teacher tool.
