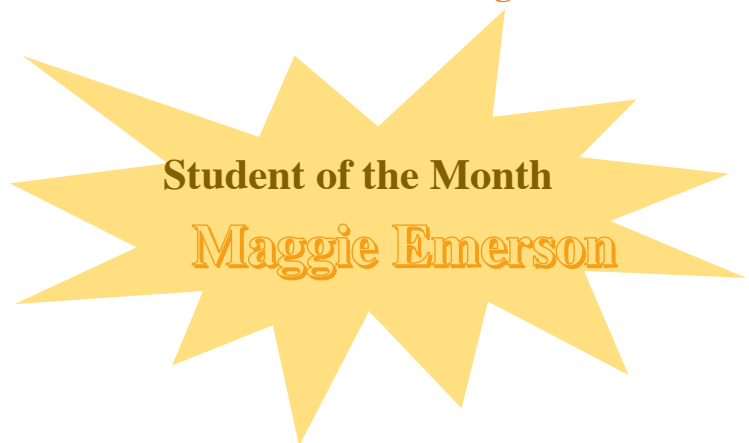
What I will be learning in October

Reading	<p>Phonics Students will learn phonemes "oo" "ee" & "ei"</p> <p>Reading Comprehension Students will read multiple stories and learn how to comprehend what they are reading</p>
Math	<p>Time Students will learn how to tell time, and will practice telling time through multiple activities</p> <p>Money Students will count and use money</p> <p>Multiplication Students will review and learn more multiplication tables</p>
Science	<p>Solar System Students will learn about each planet and will differentiate between them all</p>
Social Studies	<p>History Students will begin to learn about Pilgrims and their history to begin their knowledge for Thanksgiving</p>
Writing	<p>Creativity Students will be prompted to brainstorm and write about something from their imagination with guidelines</p>
