

**Title:** Flashcard Machine

**Version:** 1.24.2

**Developer:** Flashcard Machine Mobile, LLC

**Target Audience:** Children ages 12+

**Type(s) of software with your justification:** Flashcard Machine is a *Drill and Practice* because students already know the information they will put on the flashcards, but they need the extra practice to help them learn concepts and retain their knowledge.

**Curriculum(s) (possible environment(s) and why):** This app would be perfect for any curriculum since flashcards are universal. Students could use this before any test, quiz, or presentation in any content area. I can see this being especially useful for vocabulary quizzes or solving equations.

**Cost:** Flashcard Machine is free, but Flashcard Machine+ is \$2.99 on the App Store on iPhone. For Flashcard Machine, you have 100 free flips, 500 flips cost \$2.99, and unlimited flips are \$4.99. (A flip is “every time you flip a flashcard to reveal the definition).

**Description paragraph:**

The app looks like a desk with 2 flashcards on the bottom. On these flashcards is the navigation bar: Flashcards, Search, Map, and Settings. You start out with 4 sets: Flashcard Machine Welcome, Stock Exchange Trivia, German Soccer Teams, and Van Gogh’s Paintings (They might be different for every account made, but those are the ones I got). You can explore these to get started and they don’t use your free flips! To make a set, simply tap the (+) icon at the top right of the screen, create your title and description, and add your flashcards! If you don’t want to create your own, tap the Search icon and it will give you a list of topics and how many sets are within that topic.

**Impressions and usage paragraph:**

I like this app! It’s basic enough to not be distracting, but not too boring. I don’t have any complaints about it. The price is fair for what you get, especially since you have access to thousands of flashcards sets that you don’t have to create yourself. Since it is just a flashcard app, I would absolutely use this in my classroom. My middle school students would be able to easily navigate it, and we could share sets as a class for tutoring and peer support.
