Type(s) of software with your justification: SimpleMind – Mind Mapping would be considered a *Tool*. This app allows users to create mind maps and organize thoughts, notes, and schedules.

There are links to the website for questions and resources about the app. You can use the "Local" tab in the top left corner to start creating your own mind map! I made a to do list by simply typing what I wanted, picking my shapes, and resizing until I had my desired mind map. You can pick among bright colors, soft colors, aqua levels, and so much more! It is a very personalized tool that would be great for staying organized. It's basically a digital planner in your pocket, just way more fun!

Impressions and usage paragraph: As you could probably tell by my description paragraph, I really liked this app. I think it serves its function well without being over the top. It has several uses, but I think that it'd be best to use in the classroom as a graphic organizer creator. This would allow students to express their creativity and individuality, which is empowering.
