- Title: Homer
- Version: 3.1.4
- Publisher/Producer/Creator: Homer Learning
- Target Audience: 2 to 8
- Types of Software: Drill and Practice because it enables the children to run through problems, get incorrect responses, shown how to work through their problems, and given praise for correct responses.
- Curriculum: This could be used as a tool for students to work through problems by themselves at home, or when there is spare time in the classroom. If there is a group project and they finish early, they could be instructed to pull this up and work on some problems.
- Cost: \$9.99 monthly, \$59.99 yearly, or \$99.99 for yearly with 3 explore kits.
- Software Description: This software is designed as a building block method of teaching children different subjects. It has different windows and options for subjects and grade levels, which then leads to a variety of games to teach the student different aspects of each subject.
- Impressions: This is perhaps the better of the applications that I have thus far seen. It seems like an excellent tool to be used in the classroom or for at-home practice for learning.
