**Description:** The first thing you do is name your planboard. I would name it the semester and year that you are on. Next, you can plan out the start and end date of the semester. It will then lead you to a point where you can make your different subjects, i.e. PAP Math 8 or Algebra. You can add lesson plans to those classes, curriculum sets, and add notes for each day if you need to be reminded of anything. You can also make templates for your subjects and attach those templates to them. After that you can make a timetable, where you can create the different class times for your subject. There is not much else for this app.

**Impressions:** The app would be for someone who likes to use technology and likes to be organized using apps rather than writing out your plans. I would not use this app for daily use, since it seemed time consuming to even set it up.
