- 4.) Synopsis of what I'm doing and how I am using the tools. How are the students doing it? Individually, whole class, group of 3 etc.:

In this lesson, I will be incorporating both a YouTube video and PowerPoint to enhance the lesson. First, I will start out with the YouTube video which is a song that goes over the values of a penny, nickel, dime, and quarter. Students will sing along to the song.
