#### Basic Classroom Rules:


- 1.) I will be respectful to my teacher and classmates
- 2.) I will listen when the teacher is talking
- 3.) I will treat everyone with kindness
- 4.) I will raise my hand to speak during the lesson
- 5.) I will stay in my seat unless given permission to get up

## Technology Rules in the Classroom:

- 1.) I will hold the device with both hands to avoid breaking it
- 2.) I will only get out electronics if the teacher gives permission
- 3.) I will not have food or drinks around the electronics
- 4.) I will keep my username and password a secret
- 5.) I will treat the electronics with respect and <u>notify my teacher</u> if anything is broken

### Internet Rules:

- 1.) Cyberbullying will not be tolerated in any form.
  - a. Cyberbullying includes any form of harassment, name-calling, or targeting of another student
- 2.) Do not download anything unless I or another teacher tells you to.
- 3.) Never give out personal information online! This includes your full name, age, phone number, address, etc.
- 4.) Only get on websites and games that the teacher approves of.
- 5.) If something unfamiliar pops up on the screen of you see something that makes you uncomfortable, notify me (or another adult) immediately!

## Plagiarism, Copyright, and Fair Use Rules:

- Plagiarism is the act of taking someone else's work and saying it is your own.
- 2.) Copyright is the legal right given to someone so that their work belongs to they are in charge of who publishes, sells, and uses their work.
- 3.) Fair Use is a US copyright law that states that brief works under copyright may be used in certain circumstances. This allows us to use copyrighted information for educational purposes.

## Consequences:

### Cyberbullying:
