 - Boxes
- Cartons



Where Can I Recycle?

Recycling is something that might seem confusing, but the community makes it easy to recycle right from home! In our area, recycling bins are provided by the city. Recycling is picked up every week on Wednesday morning, so the perfect time to put out the recycle bin would be Tuesday night. If these services are not available to you, the school also has recycling options available. Make sure to email the school before dropping anything off!



Reusing Old Materials

There are some things that cannot be recycled, but this is where reusing comes in handy! There are many ways that you can take old materials and turn them into something new. For example, instead of throwing out unused clothing, think about donating them or using them as rags!
