

Flash card frenzy

3rd grade

mathematics

materials:

- flash card maker app
- 5 iPads for the use of the app
- List of exercises on the whiteboard
- exercises include hops, skips, jumps, sit-ups, and jumping jacks

This activity will consist of 25 students, divided into five groups. The iPads will be set up across the room from the groups of students. The exercises will be labeled one through five. At the teacher's prompting, the first child will go to the flash card maker app. This single tap changes the card, and the mathematical fact will be shown. The answer to the question will determine the number of exercises performed by the student. Once the student has completed the exercise, they will return to the group and the next child will repeat the same activity. This will continue until all five students in each group have finished their exercises. They will use the flash card maker app to show them the mathematical equation and the iPads will be used to display the flash card maker app.

To change the difficulty level, we could use exercises that have a higher difficulty level. With more room, we could incorporate dribbling catching in the tossing of basketballs.
