

Lesson 1:

Students will be learning about how plants grow and what all they need in order to do so. As we go through the lesson, we will be having a hands-on project of growing their own plant. Students will have a choice between a sunflower or a tulip. As the days go by, students will record themselves giving the plant what it needs in order to survive. This will ultimately create a time lapse video showing the flower grow over time.

Lesson 2:

As we are learning our alphabet, I will have the students watch a video that has activities for them to do along with it. This will be an example of what they are going to create. Students will get in groups of 4-5 and create a video of them explaining each letter of the alphabet with a picture. At the end of the video, they will collectively sing the alphabet together.

Lesson 3:

As students are learning to read and comprehend, I will have them summarize sections of a text on a sheet of paper. We will then discuss what is going on as a class, so everyone is on the same page. Then, students will create a play to act out the scene we just discussed. This will be a several days process consisting of writing the play out, getting props, and acting out while recording.

Lesson 4:

In math, students will learn about simple addition and subtraction. We will create a video as a class adding students and subtracting students giving one person at a time a chance to create

their own problem. Students can be creative and sort students by t-shirt colors, colors of hair, types of shoes, or boys vs. girls.
