U is for ultraviolet rays.

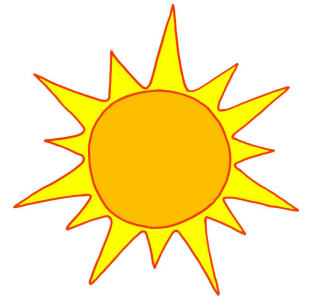
