Curriculum:

This could be used for interactive games within the classroom or even to link students to hyperdocs! Students could create QR's for the teacher that take them to a webpage or shows their answers to certain tasks. It could be used as a bellwork for students to scan something a teacher created or for students to send their bellwork via QR for the teacher.

If students are on a field trip or going on a scavenger hunt and need to be in one certain location the location could be sent via QR to the students.

COST: FREE

The app is free.

It has a store on their settings page where you can purchase items. Students would need to be told to stay away from that and not to purchase anything from the store. This is not necessary to use the app.

Software Description:

This is a QR code scanner, a QR code creator (they misspelled it in their title), and also a creator for QR code art. The app is orange, gray, white, and black. The first page lets you start off with 'Code' (create a code), 'Scan' (scan a QR), or go to settings. You start off being able to create a new one and you have a back button on every page. It has an upload button for when you're creating it. You can give your QR codes backgrounds. When you hit upload it lets you save it or share it and even gives you the option to delete it. When you create it you can send it and it will link people to whatever message you have left them.

It gives you the option to scan things which uses your camera in the IPad.

You can create a Website QR, a Phone Number one, a Note one, a Location one, an Email one, a SMS one, a Contact one, or a Clipboard QR.

Impressions:

It's basic but it is fast, responsive, easy to comprehend, and it looks good. It could be easily used by students with minimal teaching of the app necessary. The navigation is very simple and easy to understand. There is a navigation bar that lets you get to each page easily and a back button that is also easy to use and understand. The colors are gentle and they are not super bright or too dark.

This is not something that would be used a lot within a classroom but students would be able to use it easily and would likely have a good time playing with this app. There are no sound effects and no feedback but these are not exactly required.

Younger students might play around too much on an app like this but older students would not have an issue with the software.

The QR code scans and sends QR's very fast so it is extremely effective in that area. It works well and does not really shut down or have any bugs that we noticed.

Even though it has a lot of different things that it does, none of them are hard to work with and they are fairly easy to use. It doesn't slow down the app.
