<u>Paint</u>

- 1. Grade Level: 2nd
- 2. Curriculum Topic: Art Painting
- 3. Tools: For this lesson, a computer lab is needed with access to the internet, headphones, Paint, BrainPOP website, and access to Google Forms that will be shared with each student.
- 4. Synopsis: As the teacher, I will first walk my students to the school computer lab. Once we arrive there, each student will be told to find their assigned seat in the lab. Students will then sit quietly and wait for directions. After all students are seated, I will give directions to the class as to what will need to be completed while in the computer lab. Students will first be instructed to go to the BrainPOP website and click on "Arts & Music" and then on "Free Movies". Students will then need to click on "Painting" and watch the movie independently using the headphones provided for each user. After a student watches the full movie, they will then take the corresponding quiz. After completing the quiz, they will raise their hand and I, the teacher, will record their score. Then, they will be directed to open Paint and create a small painting using tints and shades that is school-acceptable and will then print it off and turn in to me. Lastly, each student will then go back to their seat in the lab and open the Google Form that was shared with them. Each student will fill out the form that would contain review questions as well as what they have learned from the activities such as vocabulary words like perspective, shade, and tint. The results of the BrainPOP quiz and the Google Forms will allow me, as the teacher, to see what students have learned from the lesson as well as information that each student has retained.
