10 Minutes	Introduction:	I will begin by calling my class to come to the carpet. We will listen to our three songs on the smartboard. There will be a song about shapes, letters, and colors. I will explain to them that I will call on a person from each team to answer the question, so that they don't fight over who is going to go when. We will play the game until we have gotten to the last question, and I will calculate which team won. I will then give that team a piece of candy, but the other group will also get a reward for participating and engaging in the game.
