

## **Clips How to Storyboard**

This how to was made to show my students how to make their letters using play dough. They could do this activity after learning the alphabet and how to write their letters. This is a great activity for them because it gives them extra practice on being able to write their letters.

Steps:

- First, roll out 2 long pieces of play dough and then roll out a small piece of play dough
- Once you have all of your pieces rolled out, put the two long pieces together at a point.
- The two long pieces should connect at the top and almost be shaped like a triangle
- Once you have that done, you grab your smaller piece and connect it in the middle.
- Make sure the piece in the middle go across the other two pieces so that it actually makes the letter A!

And there you have it, the students will have made the letter A out of playdough. I could use this activity in my classroom, and we could make capital letters out of playdough one week, and then make lower case letters out of playdough the next week. This will give the students plenty of practice.
