Basic Technology Rules

3. Do not throw, scratch or damage iPads, computers, headphones or any other device or you will be prohibited from using for the remainder of the year. You may also be responsible for damages.
4. Social Media Sites are strictly prohibited. (YouTube, Instagram, Snap Chat, Facebook, or any messenger site) Unless approved by a teacher or other administration.
5. Please follow all time limits set by teacher. (see chart on bulletin board)

Plagiarism

Students should refrain from Plagiarism. Plagiarism is the practice of taking someone else's work or ideas and passing them off as one's own. If a student is caught plagiarizing the action will result in a zero.

1. Give credit to authors when using quotes or paraphrasing.
2. Please be sure to site all sources.

Consequences for Breaking Rules

1st offense – Warning (Written)

2nd offense – Loss of privilege (phone call to parent)

3rd offense – Disciplinary action (suspension, expulsion, ISS)
