- Possible environments and why: This app would be excellent for a project-based learning system where planning is involved. It is an excellent tool, especially for older kids.
- Cost: Free, but not the main, premium version. This is the free version, which is called Collaborate and is limited. However, you can get the full version for various prices and time periods from \$12.99 to \$107.99.
- Summary: This app opens to a wide selection of different graphic organizer-type
 templates, and gives you a few tutorials as to how to use it. You can insert audio, draw,
 type, and do pretty much anything else. You can name it and share it and do anything
 else imaginable—but you are limited on how many of these separate creations you can
 make.
- Impressions: This app is relatively easy to use. It takes a little bit of figuring out to work with, but overall, we liked it a lot better than other similar apps, such as Padlet. Also, it has lots of options of templates, which works well in providing versatile options for a variety of projects and assignments.
- Pass/Fail: Pass! This app is well-made and the options are plentiful.
